When using this facility, please remember the following top tips:

- Class Dojo is ideal for everyday queries and is a positive way for teachers and parents to communicate. Our teachers try their very best to answer any queries you may have as soon as possible.
- Please allow up to 24 hours for a response. Teachers will respond as soon as they are able to, but during the day they are busy teaching the children and are not expected to respond out of normal working hours.
- Please bear in mind that some conversations are better face to face and your issue may be better resolved by making an appointment to discuss this with the class teacher or a school leader. As I'm sure you can appreciate, some exchanges could be difficult to put into a message and as a result may appear inappropriate or overly negative.
